Student Behavior —May students from school campus be diligent in their schoolwork, respect their teachers/professors, and honor their parents and those in their homes. (From Ephesians 6:2 & Matthew 7:12)
Decision Makers —May there be unity and high moral standards among teachers and administrators at school. May they walk in integrity. (From Proverbs 20:7)
Protection & Health —May students and staff at community schools turn to God who is a refuge in times of trouble. May all plans for evil be quickly thwarted and may schools move forward in good health and safety. (From Psalm 46:1)
Teachers' Wellbeing —May teachers be strengthened and refreshed at school. May teachers have patience and care for students and parents. May they have quality time with their own families. Pray that students will submit to their teacher's authority. (From Proverbs 11:25 & 1 Peter 2:13a)
Parents—May parents have discernment when to step in and assist their children, and how to communicate effectively and graciously with teachers at school. May parents do what is right and just, setting an example. (From Colossians 4:6 & Proverbs 21:3)
Students' Wellbeing—May there be healthy social and emotional wellbeing for those students at school. May students reach out to encouraging friends and mentors for help. (From Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)
Treatment of Others—May teachers, staff, and students have respect for one another atschool and offer encouragement, building others up according to their needs. (From Ephesians 4:29b)
Students' Hearts —May students who attend school flee youthful lusts and instead pursue faith in God, righteousness, love, and peace. (From 2 Timothy 2:22)
Purpose—May God's will be accomplished for school as it is in heaven. (From Matthew 6:10)
